Description of dress

Chancellor	A black robe trimmed with gold ornaments, and black Tudor bonnet with gold lace and gold tassel.
Deputy Chancellor	A black robe trimmed with gold lace, and black Tudor bonnet and gold tassel.
Pro-Chancellor	A black robe trimmed with gold lace on the facings and the shoulders, and black Tudor bonnet and gold cord trim.
Vice-Chancellor	A black robe trimmed with silver lace, and black Tudor bonnet with silver lace and silver tassel.
Member of Council	The habit of their degree or an old gold gown faced with black to a width of 6cm and the yoke to be of similar material; Tudor bonnet with gold cord trim.
Fellowship of the University	A garment of black the back of which is rouched or gathered to give a definitive yoke beneath the collar; white stole trimmed with gold tassel, and a black Tudor bonnet and silver tassel.
Edged / Lined	Edged shall mean, unless otherwise stated, edged to a depth of 10cm, the edging being turned out 1½ cm on the outside of the cowl for the Bachelors hood, and similarly for the lining on the cowl and cape of the Masters hood and Doctor of Philosophy hood. For Bachelors degrees in the Faculty of Built Environment, the hood, although lined, has the edging turned out only on the cowl, not on the cape.
Two Colours	Where two colours are stated, the first shall be to the outside edge of the cowl.
Normal Academic Dress	The gown, hood, trencher cap or bonnet appropriate to the individual.
Festal Academic Dress	The academic gown appropriate to the individual. If the gown has no colour on it (i.e. is all black) then the appropriate hood is also worn. No cap or bonnet worn. Formal dress appropriate to the occasion is worn.



Academic dress for international graduation ceremonies

The following hoods are worn at graduation ceremonies conducted overseas, instead of the specific UNSW degree hoods:

Graduate Certificate Associate Diploma Diploma	No hood.
Graduate Diploma	Old Gold (BCC115).
Bachelor	Old Gold (BCC115) edged to a depth of 5cm with Cherry (BCC185) and to a further depth of 5cm with Empire Blue (BCC87).
Master	Old Gold (BCC115) lined with Empire Blue (BCC87) and edged to a depth of 5cm with Cherry (BCC185).

Doctorate and Higher Degree graduands wear the dress specified for their degree in the appropriate sections of this document.



Associate Diploma / Diploma / Graduate Certificate

- Gown An open fronted garment of black the back of which is rouched or gathered to give a definitive yoke beneath the collar. The fronts are turned back to form facings about 5cm wide, strings are attached to the inside of the lining. The sleeves are open, slit vertically from the shoulders and caught together at the bottom of the slit (similar to BA (Camb.).
- Hood No hood is worn.
- Cap Black trencher with hard brim and crown and black tassel.



Bachelor

Gown	An open fronted garment of black the back of which is roused or gathered to give a definitive yoke beneath the collar. The fronts are turned back to form facings about 5cm wide, strings are attached to the inside of the lining. The sleeves are open, slit vertically from the shoulders and caught together at the bottom of the slit (similar to BA (Camb.).
Hood	A full shaped cape which covers the shoulders, and a cowl with a liripipe or tail. It is held in position with a neckband fitted with a cord loop which can be used to anchor it to a button or brooch. Hoods are normally worn with the cowl turned inside out for part of its width, thus showing some of its lining materials (similar to University of Cambridge).
Cap	Black trencher with hard brim and crown and black tassel.

Graduate Diploma

- Gown** An open fronted garment of black the back of which is rouched or gathered to give a definite yoke beneath the collar. The fronts are turned back to form facings about 5cm wide, strings are attached to the inside of the lining. Glove (closed) sleeves having horizontal slits to free the arms (similar to MA University of Cambridge). (As for Bachelor).
- Hood** A hood of Old Gold is worn by graduands.
- Cap** Black trencher with hard brim and crown and black tassel. (As for Bachelor).



Graduate Diploma

Master / Juris Doctor (JD) / Bachelor Medical Studies Doctor of Medicine (BMedMD)

Gown	An open fronted garment of black the back of which is rouched or gathered to give a definite yoke beneath the collar. The fronts are turned back to form facings about 5cm wide, strings are attached to the inside of the lining. Glove (closed) sleeves having horizontal slits to free the arms (similar to MA University of Cambridge).
Hood	A full shaped cape which covers the shoulders, and a cowl with a liripipe or tail. It is held in position with a neckband fitted with a cord loop which can be used to anchor it to a button or brooch. Hoods are normally worn with the cowl turned inside out for part of its width, thus showing some of its lining materials (similar to University of Cambridge).
Cap	Black trencher with hard brim and crown and black tassel (as for Bachelor).

Glove (closed) sleeves having horizontal slits to free the arms (similar to MA University of Cambridge).

Hood Simple shape consisting of cowl only without the cape but possible to fold in such a shape as to show the lining. (Similar to University of Oxford). Scarlet lined with Imperial Purple (BCC109). Cap Black Tudor bonnet with gold cord trim.
